- I. Meeting was called to order at 6:12 pm. Pledge of Allegiance was recited by officers and members. All officers were in attendance as well as some members.

- III. Reading of two previous minutes was read. There being no correction. Larry Benally motioned, was seconded by Elbert Woody to approve it as read. 20 in favor, 00 opposed and 01 abstention.
- IV. Reports:
 - A. Local: Commander Dedman gave a report about the FY 2025 Veteran Trust, how the funds are allocated for each 110 Chapters. He said it depends on how many Veteran, survivors, and gold mothers each chapter has. He said, they found out that some veterans got financial assistance from different chapters.
 - B. No agency report. It was suppose to have been last Friday, Sept. 26, but was cancelled due to floods in some areas. It was reschedule to Monday the 29th, but neither him or the vice did not attend.
 - C. Financial: When we did our FY 2025 of \$81,489, it was just for hardship, energy and self-help. Not for program or office supplies. Navajp Nation council allocated \$5,000 for each chapter to use for program and office supplies. Some discussion were made by some members as how to use the funds. Members decided to use

\$2,500 for Veteran Day and \$250 for Memorial day Event. Larry Benally motioned, was seconded by Alexander Dedman to use the funds for Veteran Day and Memorial Day Event. 19 in favor, 00 opposed, and 02 absention.

V. Unfinished Business:

A. We still need some supplies to finish the Purple Heart Program. The two signs are going to posted by the old windmill and the other one is going be across Rena Brown's place. Will be discussed at future meetings.
