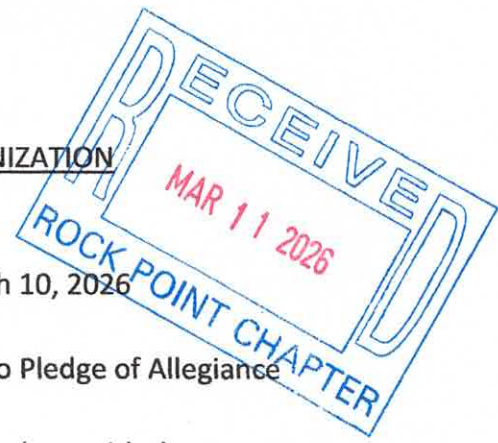

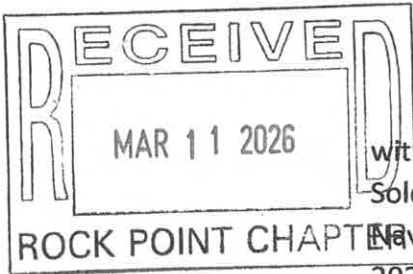

1. **Call meeting to order:** Commander Paul Jones at 10:20 am March 10, 2026
2. **Invocation:** Lead by Vice Commander Harrison Begay
3. **Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence:** There was no flag so no Pledge of Allegiance but Commander Paul Jones lead the Moment of Silence.
4. **Roll Call:** Commander and Vice Commander were at the meeting along with the Secretary.
5. **Review and Adopt the Agenda 1st Motion: Daniel Begay 2nd Motion: Edmunda Store**

- C) **Report from Randolph Begay Jr.** Introduced himself and read his "2026 Memorial Monument Park Site & Ceremony Flag Blessing- Memorial Day" (Still in the Planning Stage) Honor Guard from Farmington New Mexico will be at the event, asked the Veterans to do Ceremonial Flag Unfolding & Blessing to take place there. A Right away has been updated with a Resolution with Rock Point Chapter House. But there has been no Ground Breaking or Blessing for the Park site yet. We asked for those to be done and proof of confirmation of who is coming to the event as their Speakers.
