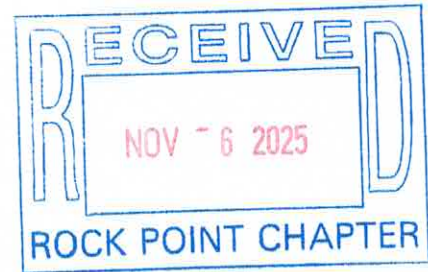

1. **Call meeting to order:** Vice Commander Harrison Begay at 10:35 am November 5, 2025
2. **Invocation:** Lead by Commander Paul Jones

8. **Reports:**

A) **Commander:** Paul Jones attended CVO meeting in Chinle the 31st of October which was already done by 12:30 pm. Paula was talking about how Rock Point Veterans Organization are on top of things turning in paperwork on time for Budget. Some of the other Organization were wanting to borrow Our Secretary. Asked about Catering at the Chapter House because we were told certain things can't be purchased with our Budget.

B) **Vice-Commander:** Harrison Begay Vice-Commander, An email to Carl Slater concerning limitations of use for the \$5,000 Veterans Allocation and Rock Point is under Kayenta ASC. Asking if there is an establishment policy or ASC guidance outlining allowable Veterans expenditures and required approval processes for these funds? Native American Heritage Day is a Civil Holiday observed on the day after Thanksgiving even though it faces heavy criticism. A press release from the Office of the Speaker from the Navajo Nation regarding where families can get food assistance who were getting SNAP benefits. Due to the Government shutdown there are several resources listed.

C) **Secretary:** Been working with Coltyn Littleben about T-shirt and how the designs should be. Visited him at his home, to ask if he is able to make the tshirts even though he hasn't gotten paid for them yet until Checks are printed. Thankful for him to work with us.
