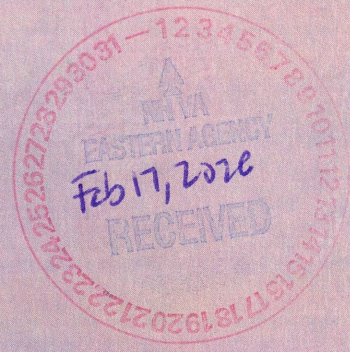

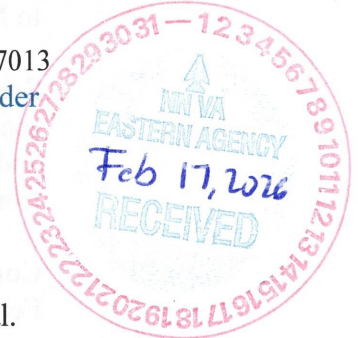

Housing Application drive and presentation also took place at Standing Rock Chapter as they gave a lot of information out and explained both new and renovations policies. The VTF was also covered NNVA staff were present and took questions and answered grassroots veterans to give clarity. Our Commander for Eastern also steps aside from NNAC, and commanders voted Vice Commander Hubert Smith to be the new Commander is also still networking with NM Ramp Project, Habitat for Humanity and open for Elizabeth Dole. We have a lot of resources out there and need to reach out so we can be those entities to Ojo Encino to help veterans. Commander is also waiting for a response on when she will have a sit down with Legislator Michelle Paulene Abeyta and Two Senators for Capital Outlay funding for possibility of a new veteran center for Ojo Encino.
