Monthly Meeting Minutes November 19, 2025



Blue Gap/Tachee Veteran Organization monthly meeting was called to order by Commander EYazzie at 1:15 pm with 14 veterans and visitors present. Pledge of Allegiance was recited and invocation was given by Secretary LTulley. Moment of Silence was also observed.

The meeting agenda needed no correction, AJones motioned to accept the agenda and was seconded JBurbank, with vote count Yes 14 No 0 Abstained 1.

Secretary LTulley read the last meeting's minutes and JBurbank motioned to accept the minutes as read, EBenally seconded the motion with vote count: Yes 14 No 0 Abstained

Reports were made as following: 1. Commander Eddie Yazzie – no meeting attendance to report but Vice Commander KGlover will give report on her first CNVO meeting later. Trust Fund Budget update will be given when topic comes up on the agenda. There are clothing and stuff on the table which came from Chinle Veteran's office.

2. Vice Commander Kim Glover reported that she attended CNVO meeting held Chinle Catholic Church hall on October 31st. All 16 chapters were present. BG/T has a total of 51 veterans registered: 13 updated their info, 8 no update, 3 never funded and 1 lacked info. There are 6 surviving spouse registered: 2 updated, 1 no update, 3 never funded, 0 lacked info. Allocation amount for BG/T veterans: \$70,080 = 33 Males, 4 Females, 6 Surviving Spouse, 0 Gold Star, totals 43. Current budget as of October 24 BG/T has spent 14%, total 70,080 – 9,600 = 60,480. Fund 16 Chapter Vet Fund: BG/T FY25 carryover 5253.29 plus FY26 5000.00 = \$10,253.29. BG/T 2 veterans have applied for new housing, apply on line if interested. CNVO meeting ended quickly as the executive director, housing manager, deputy director, Veterans' Liaison, CNVO Vice Commander were no show. There remains discrepancy in the total count of BG/T veterans registered, its either 43 or 51 and 8 veterans in limbo. BG/T to host CNVO on September 25, 2025.

3. Secretary LTulley: expressed her appreciation to all the veterans and encouraged by having them know someone is praying for them. A lady named Jackie from Many Farms is willing to assist anyone who needs a wheel chair ramp. There are information from the State of Arizona who can help with financial assistance if needed.

4. Veteran Service Officer Paula Begay – no show 5. Honorable Council Delegate/ Representative – no show. 6. Blue Gap Chapter Harrison Blie – presently \$2425.33 for food, 1627.96 for gifts and \$5000.00 is still coming [5253.29 + 5000 = 10253.29] in chapter budget. Check for \$1200 is ready to purchase food from TnR Market, Lauretta Tulley volunteered to will pay \$8.64.

Old Business:

1. BG/T Veteran Budget: 70,080=3600 Stipend+33240 Hardship+33240 Energy.

14 sign up for hardship ($400 \times 14 = 5600$; $33240 - 5600 = 27,640$)

18 for Energy ($400 \times 18 = 7200$; $33240 - 7200 = 26,040$)

[total 32 veterans used $\$53,680 = 27640 + 26040$; $\$12,800 = 66,480 - 53,680$]

2. BG/T Veteran Dinner – chapter printed \$1200 check for food purchase at TnR. LTulley will pay \$9.00 for the reminding amount. AJones will pick up food on Tuesday, November 25. AYazzie said Senior Center should be ready for use by Wednesday November 26.

New Business 1. Replace BG/T Veteran Sign, Post AZ, NN, and POW flags in chapter, and hang name plaque on chapter walls in recognition of veterans – all these ideas have been presented to the group; move topic to next meeting.

Blue Gap Chapter meeting on December 12, 2025. Move next money request to next BG/T Veteran Organization meeting December 10.

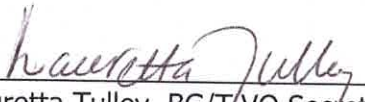
