MEETING MINUTES

10/07/25



1. **Call meeting to order:** Vice Commander Harrison Begay at 10:11 am October 7, 2025.
2. **Invocation:** Lead by Vice Commander Harrison Begay
3. **Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence:** Vice Commander Harrison Begay lead the Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence.
4. **Roll Call:** Commander and Vice Commander were at the meeting along with the Secretary.
5. **Review and Adopt the Agenda:** Commander Paul Jones read the agenda with no addition or delegation. Raymond Jones made the 1st motion to accept the agenda as read. 2nd motion was by Johnny Jones. The motion was approved by a Vote of 12 in favor, 0 opposed and 1 abstained.
6. **Minutes September 2, 2025 and September 18, 2025 Special Meetings:** Meeting Minutes from Regular meeting on September 2, 2025 and Special Meeting on September 18, 2025 was read by Secretary Angeline Begay. No questions of concerns with both minutes being read. Raymond Jones made the 1st motion, 2nd motion by Joe Hatathle with approved Vote of 14 in favor 0 opposed and 1 abstained.
7. **Reports:**
 - A) **Commander:** Paul Jones attended Chinle Agency meeting September 30th, 2025. Supervisor Paula was talking about budgets when he showed up. She said some good words for Rock Point Veterans Organization for turning in Budget, cleared and updated. Once again, a lot of people listed on the Agenda didn't show up to the meeting except the House Manager. Pinon Wellness was still on the agenda needing funds. Attended planning meeting where they talked about "rules" for livestock. For instance, if they are outside the fence they will be taken.
 - B) **Vice-Commander:** Harrison Begay Vice-Commander, VTF 2026 Budget submitted to Chinle VA office September 22, 2025. Memorandum dated September 25, 2025 from Benjamin Benallie for Account Maintenance Specialist to these funds for catering, gifts/awards and office supplies. Therefore, no allocation for line-item program in FY 2026 CVO Veterans Trust Fund. Additional \$5,000 to Chapter Veteran Organization Rock Point amount of \$6,722.33. We need to budget for \$5,000 and submit to Chapter Administration. Voting by mail is Democracy at work, it makes Election more accessible, more secure and more representative. Which is exactly why Donald Trump wants to get rid of it. Trump promised to "lead a movement to get rid of MAIL-IN BALLOTS, to sign an executive order banning them. Never mind that the constitution gives authority over elections to the states., not the President. *show your paper* designed to silence millions of Americans.



After Trump meeting democrats at The White House over the budget, he said "Democrats are a disgrace" All Americans, it is our Duty to rise and defend it. Veterans across this nation were standing shoulder to shoulder, answering that call. Hundreds of Veterans marched to congress and The White House in unity and resolve. Trump using the National guards and the military against the American People. Navajo Nation funding disputes President line items vetoes FY 2026 budget. Before the council would over-ride the President's Vetoes but the people voted for NN President to veto budget line items. NN council can't override the President's veto, Impeaching the Navajo Nation President. Resolution by a Chapter urging the NN Council to begin impeachment proceedings, introduction of articles of impeachment of 16 million ARPA federal funds. Freedom of speech under attack by Trump administration. Military should use "Dangerous cities as training grounds" National Guard deployment to where democrats are governors and mayors. Governors are suing him to stop. The uniform cord of Military justice requires service members to obey only lawful orders. Government shutdown, Who's at Fault?
