WHERE AS:

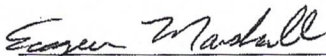

- 2. This is to ensure that the Iyanbito Veterans Organization will be able to assist more veterans if not all with funding.

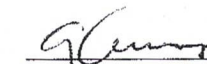
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

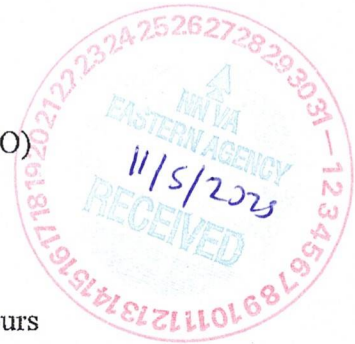

MEETING MINUTES
IYANBITO VETERANS ORGANIZATION (IVO)

Thursday October 9th, 2025 @ 1700 hrs.



1. Commander Eugene Marshall called the meeting to order at 1715 hours
Roll call by Secretary/Treasurer Eunice Skeet
Invocation by Commander Eugene Marshall
Pledge of Allegiance by all in attendance
Moment of silence by all in attendance
2. Commander Marshall reviewed the meeting agenda. Motion to accept the agenda made by Phillip Smith and Second by Jones Padilla. Commander Marshall opened the floor for any corrections or add-ons to the agenda. No corrections or add-ons. A vote was taken with 12 In Favor, 0 Opposed, and 1 Abstained.
