3. Pursuant to Nahata Commission Governance Resolution # 04-05-324, the Nahata Dziil Veteran Organization was established to administer the operation of the organization and to identify, prioritize, and implement resources to meet the needs of local Navajo Veterans; and
4. Nahata Dziil Commission Governance is a certified chapter that is recognized by the Navajo Nation Council, pursuant to 26 NNC Section 3, and pursuant 11 NNC Part 1 Section 10, the Navajo Nation Council adopted the Navajo Nation Local Government Act which direct local chapters to promote all matters that affect the local community members and to make appropriate decisions, recommendations and advocate on their basis; and
5. Nahata Dziil Chapter converted its government into the Nahata Dziil Commission Governance based on the voice of the people; and
6. With the cost of living steadily on the rise, an increase of about 4%-8% would benefit existing and future Navajo Nation veterans.
