1. The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization has been in existence since 1970 and has changed its name from Oak Springs and Pine Springs Chapter Veterans Organization to Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization, which was approved on March 5, 2017, along with its Plan of Operation, which was changed in October 2017; and,
2. One of the main purposes of the Veterans organization is to advocate on issues, concerns, and needs of Navajo Veterans registered within the Oak Springs and Pine Springs communities and to ensure that the Veterans get the benefits they have earned and to represent them at the Local, Tribal, County, State, and Federal levels; and,
3. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation Veterans Act; Title II, Section One (E, I, M, N, O, R, T); SS-1032 (B-5,9,10), the Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization is duly recognized by the Navajo Nation; and,
4. Pursuant to the Navajo Nation Council Resolution CMA-25-71; The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization is established under the Navajo Nation Veterans Administration with falls under the Executive Branch of the Navajo Nation Government; and,
5. The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization recognizes and acknowledges that it is entrusted to strive toward unification of all Navajo Nation veterans and local leadership to provide and coordinate with the needs of the veteran; and,
6. The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization has selected and recognized Ms. Patricia Burnside, US Marine Corps Woman Veteran, whereby accepts the position of CVO Commander; and,
7. The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization has selected and recognized Ms. Eleanor Yazzie, US Army Woman Veteran, whereby accepts the position of CVO Vice Commander; and,
8. The Teel'chinti'/T'iis'iiahi Veterans Organization has selected and recognized Ms. Tina Yazzie, US Army Woman Veteran, whereby accepts the position of CVO Secretary for second term; and,
