

**RESOLUTION OF THE BAHASTL'AH (TWIN LAKES) VETERANS' ORGANIZATION
AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF CAP ON THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE AND
RESTORING BACK TO \$400 FOR HARDSHIP, AND ENERGY ASSISTANCE UNDER
THE TRUST FUNDS POLICIES**

WHEREAS:

1. The Bahastl'ah (Twin Lakes) Veteran Organization has a Plan of Operation and is recognized as Bahastl'ah (Twin Lakes) Veterans Origination authorized to manage and expend its Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) Veterans Trust Funds allocations; and
2. The Bahastl'ah (Twin Lakes) Veterans Organization had implemented a cap on the Energy Assistance within the Navajo Nation Trust Funds during the 2025 fiscal year.
3. The Bahastl'ah (Twin Lakes) Veterans Organization, officially remove the cap on energy assistance, through said Resolution by vote of the Bahastl'ah (Twin Lakes) Veterans organization and restore back to \$400 for Veterans and Surviving Spouses to utilize.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

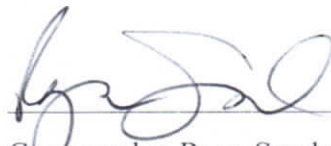
