# RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

20th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - Fourth Year, 2006

#### AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES, AND FINANCE; ENACTING THE VETERANS TRUST FUND AMENDMENTS ACT OF 2006, AMENDING TITLE 12 OF THE NAVAJO NATION CODE, 12 N.N.C. §1171

#### BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Enactment of the Veterans Trust Fund Amendments
Act of 2006

The Navajo Nation Council hereby enacts the Veterans Trust Fund Amendments Act of 2006.

Section 2. Findings and Purpose

The Navajo Nation Council hereby finds that the legitimate needs of Navajo veterans, whether arising from the current wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, or prior armed conflicts exceed the financial resources which are currently available to meet such needs.

The purpose of the Veterans Trust Fund Amendments Act of 2006 is to provide a statutory set-aside of funds from the annual revenues of the Navajo Nation for the purpose of meeting the legitimate needs of Navajo veterans.

Section 3. Amendments to Title 12 Navajo Nation Code

The Navajo Nation Council hereby amends the Navajo Nation Code, Title 12, as follows:

#### \$1171. Establishment

The "Navajo Nation Veterans Trust Fund" hereinafter the "Trust Fund" is established with an initial appropriation of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) from revenues from Undesignated Tribal Reserves. <u>Each year</u>, during the appropriation of the Navajo Nation Comprehensive

Budget, the Navajo Nation Council shall budget a sum equal to at least four percent (4%) of any and all projected revenues of the Navajo Nation, including, but not limited to revenues received from taxes, oil and gas mining and minerals, timber, land rentals, interest and dividends, gain on sale of securities and other revenue producing activities for transfer to the Fund. Any funds deposited into the Trust Fund, plus accrued interest, shall be used only as provided for as explained hereinafter.

#### Section 4. Codification

The provisions of this Act which amend or adopt new sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate these amendments within the next recodification or supplement of the Navajo Nation Code, to the extent practicable.

#### Section 5. Savings Clause

Should any provisions of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those portions of this Act which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
